

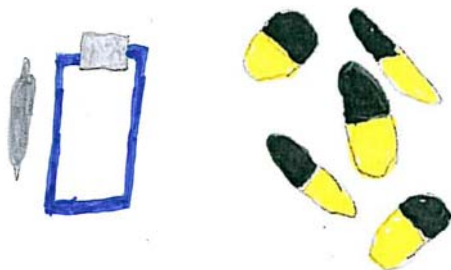
# My Stay In Hospital
